WHAT IS A DORA ??

• A public area where alcoholic beverages can be purchased in a designated cup from a permitted establishment and carried and consumed within the district

• New Indiana law went into effect 07/01/2023

WHY A DORA ?? • GOALS:

- To create an environment in the Downtown/Riverfront area where people want to spend time which supports local businesses.
- Support the Revitalization and Redevelopment of our historic Downtown
- Create a livable, walkable downtown and main street with opportunities to shop, work, live and discover recreational, cultural and heritage opportunities

-Since 1995 OVER 120 DORA districts have been created in Ohio.





Downtown Jasper Social District Rules

1.Social District Daily Hours

Noon - 09:00 pm

 Alcoholic beverages may only be consumed in designated cups from participating liquor establishments.
Alcoholic beverages may only be consumed inside the Downtown Jasper Social District.

4. Possession of an open container of alcohol in a motor vehicle and other rule violations may constitute a class C infraction.
