

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF JASPER
NOVEMBER 28, 2023**

The Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Jasper, Indiana, met in special session at 9:00 am on Tuesday, November 28, 2023.

CALL TO ORDER
